Reasoning: Most U17 teams can play a full game in less than 2hrs which is a typical rental time range.

- 2) Proposed Rules Changes No submissions received.
- 3) NW Playing Rules and Regulations
 - a. Biggest change from previous is years is in regard to the bond. Bond is still \$100, however we used to hold this bond indefinitely. Over time some associations did not top up as fees increased and other teams disappeared from the league. The change to bond is as follows: The bond is nonrefundable. NW Fastpitch will keep the bond for a period of up to 3 years of inactivity in the league. After 3 years of inactivity the bond will be absorbed by the league as payment for holding the spot and not having to be voted back into the league. This rule would take place starting this year and will not be back dated to whenever payment was received.

Reasoning: It is easier to maintain for the league and encourages centres to rejoin North Waterloo after a brief hiatus.
